POSITION SUMMARY

The Cadet Supervisor is responsible for the training, mentorship, and evaluation of cadet officials enrolled in the volleyball officiating program. Working alongside the Association's Mechanics Chair and Rules Interpreter, the supervisor guides cadets through rules education, on-court mechanics, observations and evaluations to foster the next generation of certified, confident volleyball officials at the high school level.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and facilitate training sessions covering volleyball rules, officiating mechanics, and initial court experiences of cadets.
- Develop and adapt processes for the observation of cadets during matches and live game assignments, which will provide constructive written and verbal feedback.
- Track each cadet's development progress and maintain accurate training and evaluation records.
- Instruct cadets on current NFHS rules, officiating standards, and protocols.
- Coordinate with assigners and program staff to schedule cadet match observations and evaluations.
- Serve as a point of contact and mentor for cadets, addressing questions, concerns, and professional development needs.
- Model professionalism, ethical conduct, and sportsmanship at all times.
- Submit evaluation reports and program documentation as required by the association's Executive Council.
- Other duties as assigned by the Executive Council
